WORKSHOPS

We offer on-site and off-site **half-day** or **full-day workshops**, all tailored to enhance learning and ignite imagination. Previous sessions have included:

- Creative workshops linked to classroom topics and the national curriculum
- Confidence and oracy development
- Exploring key issues and themes through drama
- Supporting school productions and nativity plays
- One-day 'create and perform' experiences
- Theatre skills development
- Arts Award support
- Theatre tours and careers-focused sessions



PROJECTS

Royal Shakespeare Company (RSC) Associate Schools Programme

As a proud partner of the RSC, we deliver this transformative programme where teachers use real RSC rehearsal techniques to unlock students' passion for language. Suitable for all learners, this programme boosts confidence, deepens understanding, and enhances analytical skills in both speech and writing.

Taking part in this project costs £450 per academic year for two years, and each year includes:

- 3 CPD sessions for up to 2 staff
- 2 cluster meetings
- 2 visits to your school from a Drama Worker
- 1 performance event at Hull Truck Theatre for up to 2 classes

Creative Revision Sessions

Bring GCSE texts to life! Our Drama Workers and professional actors work with KS4 classes to creatively explore set texts such as plays by William Shakespeare, *An Inspector Calls* by J.B. Priestley, works by Willy Russell, Arthur Miller and more — helping to cement knowledge in preparation for exams.



Creative Learning Adventures

Immersive drama-based adventures that bring learning to life. Creative Learning Adventures can be tailored to any subject and are designed in collaboration with classroom teachers. Previous themes include Secret Agent Academy – a spy-themed in-school mission developing verbal reasoning and numeracy through imaginative play.

Curriculum Festivals

We'll spend a full week at your school, working with pupils across year groups to create an unforgettable performance, shared on a Friday afternoon – a true celebration of learning through creativity.

Ten-Week Drama Projects

Longer term drama projects led by our team over the course of a full term. These projects inspire creativity, improve communication, and offer students the opportunity to create something truly special.

Holiday Activities

Keep children and young people engaged, inspired and fulfilled during the school holidays with our dynamic drama-based projects. These creative sessions provide a fun, safe and stimulating environment – perfect for building confidence, teamwork and imagination outside of term time.

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YEAR-ROUND PARTNERSHIPS

Bring the power of drama into your school all year round. Our Drama Workers can become part of your school community - running PPA sessions, leading after-school youth theatre groups, and delivering creative projects that enrich curriculum learning.

We offer flexible partnership models: from half-day weekly visits to full-day or termly engagements. Each partnership is co-designed with school leaders to align perfectly with your setting's goals and needs.

The costs of a Drama Worker in your setting every week for the whole academic year:

£6,045 for a half-day session every week (£155 × 39 weeks)

£8,775 for a full school day every week (£225 × 39 weeks)
